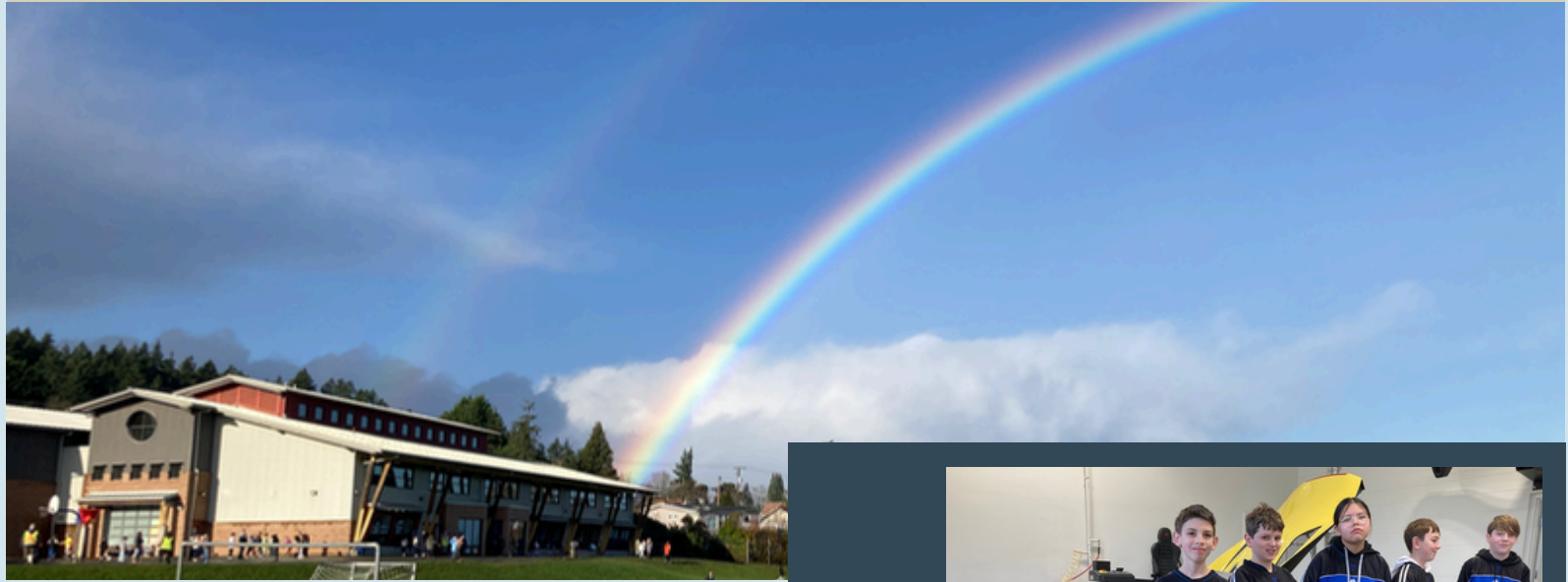

Salmon Egg Arrival: On Tuesday, January 27, 100 coho salmon eggs arrived at Crofton to continue their life cycle with Divisions 3 and 4. Once the eggs hatch and grow into fry over the next few months, our students will release them into the Cowichan River for them to continue their journey to the Pacific Ocean. As part of the Stream to Sea Program with Fisheries and Oceans Canada, we raise salmon in the classroom in order to protect them during their most vulnerable life stages, thus giving them a fighting chance for long-term survival. We are so excited to be part of this program once again this year.

KPop Club: In January Mrs. Greenhow started a KPop Club at school for K-6 students, who wished to listen to music, learn lyrics to popular songs, discover new artists, or colour and craft. On Mondays primary students enjoy listening to the soundtrack from KPop Demon Hunters and colouring thematic pictures, while on Fridays the intermediate students have started to watch music videos and learn lyrics to songs by Stray Kids. Throughout the upcoming weeks there will be a wide variety of things to do and learn about this music genre.
